## TOURNAMENT RULES

## This tournament is certified by the USBC.

1. Open only to ADULT members of the USBC who are certified through the Portage County USBC.
2. To determine your average for this tournament use the first of the following that can be met:
a. Your highest 21 or more game USBC certified average from last season or most recent summer season (from the average book or bowl.com) in Portage County or outside Portage County,
b. Your highest 21 or more game USBC league average as of the day of the tournament for this year in Portage County or outside Portage County PLEASE bring a current standings sheet to the tournament, so it can be verified before prize money is paid),
c. If you have no USBC certified average from this year with 21 or more games and no USBC certified average from last season or latest summer session, use 230.
3. Bowlers are responsible for verifying their own averages, whether submitted by the bowler or others (see USBC Rule 319a-3).
4. Bowlers must report previous tournament prize winnings as a condition for entry according to USBC Rule 319d. Failure to comply with these provisions is cause for a forfeiture of entry fee and prize winnings.
5. USBC Rule 319 e about reporting tournament scores applies to this tournament. Failure to use the adjusted average in accordance with the foregoing is cause for forfeiture of entry fee and prize winnings.
6. To determine handicap, use $90 \%$ of the difference between bowler's average and 230 . Bowlers with no qualifying average must use a 230 average and zero handicap. Bowlers with averages higher than 230 use zero handicap.
7. Entry fee of $\mathbf{s} 40.00$ per bowler must be submitted by $9: 00$ pm on Saturday November 28 th, 2020 , of which $\mathbf{s} 28$ goes into the prize fund. Day of entries will be charged a $\$ 10.00$ late entry fee that will be added to the prize fund. This money will be applied to the prize fund of the tournament. For all entry fees: 99 lineage and $\dot{\leqslant} 3$ expenses. Walk-ins are welcome provided that there are still lanes available.
8. No PBA members will be allowed to bowl unless they have bowled 21 or more games in a certified league in Portage County this season.
9. Disputes and appeals must be submitted to the tournament director in writing before prize money is paid (see USBC Rule 329).
10. The qualifying round will be one squad of 4 games across 8 lanes. From qualifying: at least 1 in 5 bowlers will cash and advance to the semi finals, pins DO NOT carry over. Semi-finals are 3 games. Six bowlers will advance to the finals. A tie for the final qualifying spot will be broken with a 9 th and 10 th frame roll-off. Handicap for this roll-off will be $20 \%$ of each bowlers per game handicap. Any finals matches that end in a tie will also follow this roll-off process.
11. The finals will be a bracket format based on semi-final round seeding. The first round of the bracket will consist of the 3 rd place vs. $6^{\text {th }}$ place and $4^{\text {th }}$ place vs $5^{\text {th }}$ place teams from semi-finals. The winner of those matches will face the $1^{\text {st }}$ and $2^{\text {nd }}$ place teams who have a bye in the first round. The winner of those matches will face each other for the championship. The higher seed will choose starting lane throughout the finals. The lowest squad losers will finish $5^{\text {th }}$ and $6^{\text {th }}$ based on their semi finals scores, likewise in the $2^{\text {nd }}$ round, the losers will place $3^{\text {rd }}$ and $4^{\text {th }}$.
12. If the tournament has less than 30 total entries there will be no semi finals, the top 1 in 5 will advance right to the finals.
13. No checks will be accepted within seven days of the tournament.
14. Max entries 96 bowlers
15. Only entries paid in full will guarantee a spot in the tournament.
16. All bad checks will be charged at least the amount of check plus bank fees. If not paid, legal action and USBC disqualification will be pursued.
17. Entries close 30 minutes prior to the start of tournament.
18. $100 \%$ of the prize money collected will be returned.
