Twenty-ninth Annual Senior Handicap Tournament Rules

1. All entrants and/or replacements must be current female members in good standing in their local association, Ohio USBC WBA, and at least 55 years of age at time of participation.
2. There will be separate divisions for each of five age classifications as follows:
Division 1 - 75 years and Older
Division 2 - 70 through 74 years Division 4 - 60 through 64 years
Division 3 - 65 through 69 years Division 5 - 55 through 59 years
Classification will be determined on proof of age at time of participation
3. This will be a classified, handicap singles tournament consisting of six (6) games. Total pins for the 6 games, including handicap of 80% based on 200 scratch, will determine the winner in each division. Entrants are eligible to compete only once in the tournament.
4. Each division winner will have the opportunity to participate in the USBC National Senior Tournament to be held in 2010, with entry fee paid. If the division winner is unable to participate in the USBC National Senior Tournament, the second, third, or fourth-place finishers will be given the option with alternate selections made in order of finish.
5. In case of a tie for the winner in any division, Co-champions will be declared for the Ohio USBC WBA Senior Handicap Tournament. As only one division winner is eligible to compete in the USBC National Senior Tournament, the national participant will be determined by the highest game, including handicap, of the 6-game series. If a champion is unable to attend the USBC National Tournament, she will receive a free entry into the next year's Senior Tournament.
6. Entrants will use their highest final Ohio USBC certified league average as of the end of the 2008-09 winter season of at least 21 games or more. If no 2008-09 winter season average, the highest average of a certified 2009 summer league of at least 21 games may be used. If no previous average, bowler may use highest current certified league average of at least 12 games at time of bowling. If no qualifying average, entrant must bowl scratch.
- 7. ENTRIES WILL CLOSE OCTOBER 7, 2009**
8. The ratio of prizes will be at least 1 prize for each 5 participants in each division.
9. Any bowler arriving late shall begin play and the score shall count beginning in the frame then being bowled.
10. Rule 319a(2) - (10-pin average increase) will not apply.
Rule 319a(3) - (bowler responsibility for correct average) will apply.
Rule 319d - (\$300.00 prize winnings) will not apply.
Rule 319e - (average adjustment) will not apply.
11. If assigned squads are acceptable to participating bowler, there will be no changes in schedule at tournament site except in extreme emergency. If assigned squads are not acceptable, bowler must notify Ohio USBC WBA state office (937-436-2695) within 7 days of receipt of confirmation.
12. The entrant whose name appears on entry, or her authorized replacement, hereby agrees that the Ohio USBC WBA, its officers and agents, shall be liable only to the extent of returning entry fee if and when entrant shall be prevented from bowling in the tournament through delay, unexpected yet necessary schedule change, or premature termination of the tournament, which may be brought about by war, national emergency or emergencies of causes relating thereto or there from, fires, strikes, lockout or labor difficulties beyond the control of the Ohio USBC WBA.
13. No monies will be refunded after the deadline date (October 7, 2009)
14. Any bowler who misses one frame or more by not being present and ready to bowl when it is her turn shall not be credited with any pins for frames missed.
