## Portage County Masters Rules

1. This tournament is certified by the United States Bowling Congress and unless otherwise modified, all USBC rules will apply.
2. The tournament is open only to USBC certified bowlers. USBC members who are not certified through Portage County USBC BA must fill out a certification card and pay any local dues. Women certified through Portage County USBC WBA must also certify through Portage County USBC BA to bowl in this tournament. Certification (sanction) cards will be sold the day of the tournament.
3. The entry fee is \$65.00: \$46.00 for the prize fund, \$16.50 for lineage, and \$2.50 for expenses. An additional fee of \$5.00 will be added for entries submitted the day of the tournament, and that fee will be added to the prize fund. All prize money collected will be awarded 100%. Prize amounts and the number of prizes will be awarded in each division on the basis of the number of entries in that division only.
4. The Qualifying round will be two four-game sets across eight lanes at two different bowling centers, one on Saturday and one on Sunday. One in four bowlers in each division will qualify for the Semi-Final round based on the total pin fall in the Qualifying round. Any ties for the last qualifying spot will be broken with a 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> frame roll-off. All bowlers who make the semi-finals will be paid prize money.
5. The Semi-Final round will be four games across eight lanes. **Scores from the Qualifying round do carry over to the Semi-Finals.** The top four scorers after the Semi-Final round will bowl in a step-ladder Final. Position in the step-ladder Final will be determined by total pin fall after the Semi-Final round. Scores do not carry over into the Finals. In case of a tie for any position in the Finals, a 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> frame roll-off will break the tie. Any other ties in the prize list below the top four will be awarded equal prize amounts.
6. Current members of the PBA or other professional bowling associations are not eligible for this tournament unless they have bowled 21 or more games in a certified league in Portage County during the current bowling season.
7. No checks will be accepted after Feb. 1, 2010.
8. No entries will be accepted unless accompanied by full payment.
9. Entries close 30 minutes prior to the scheduled starting time of the first session.
10. Entries are limited to 80.
